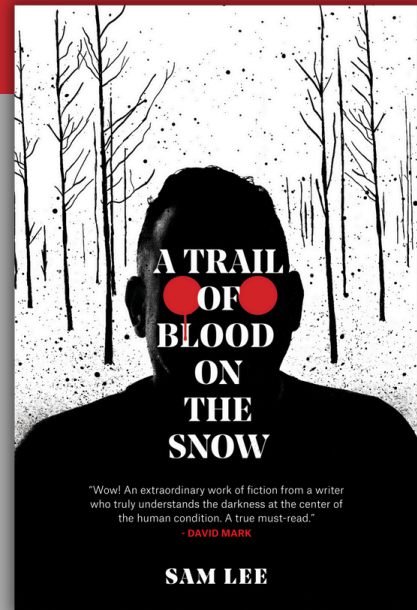

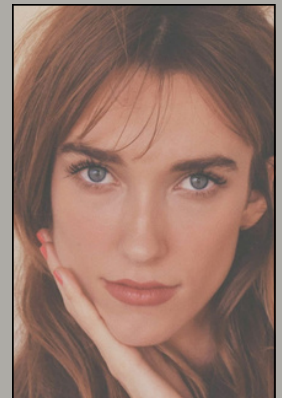
Rex acts. Is this the making of a monster, or the breaking of a man?
